FIRE PIT

As you all know there is a lot of dry grass and the wind can blow constantly or in surprising gusts therefore no outside fire built with combustible material shall be left unattended. Every fire pit must have an approved screen for either commercial or constructed fire pit. Therefore before building a fire pit please purchase the screen so it fits on top of the bricks. If the fire pit is constructed it will at the minimum have three layers of brick. The ground will be prepared for the bricks so the connecting edges form a tight bond. The bricks will overlap as shown below. Any combustible material within two feet of the the fire pit will be cut to ground level and all materials cleaned from the two foot area. Every fire pit must be inspected by a member of the MVEARB or their designee before a fire maybe lighted. Before leaving the fire after it has been burning it must be completely extinguished with no potential for reigniting. The first fine for leaving an unattended fire or not properly extinguishing is \$50 and \$100 for the second plus the banning of any further burning on that property with the current ownership. We all understand the joy of sitting by a fire but it is also the most significant danger to life and property in the subdivision and must be considered a privilege and not a right.
